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# ISWS GROUNDWATER SECTION GOALS

- Create interactive online web applications for groundwater resources and water use
- Display aquifer maps, well locations and attributes, withdrawal rates
- Display what water sources municipalities draw from and if they purchase water
- Ability to graph and download data
- Similar to IEPA SWAP site and ILWATER, but more focused on themes
- Fill the need for planners, engineers, and water operators to view and have access to groundwater/surface water withdrawal data

#### **Currently Have:**

- Web Application that displays all reported Illinois Water Inventory Program (IWIP)
   data at Public Water Supply Wells (1980-2013)
- Statewide map of where Municipalities get their water from, who they purchase from, and in what amount

## Currently Working On:

- Displaying all IWIP data for Public Water Supply Intakes (Surface Water Component)
- Displaying all IWIP data for Industrial and Irrigation Use
- Add Interpreted IWIP data (filling in gaps/missing reported data)

## Future Web Applications:

- Web Application for viewing water level data (mass measurements and real-time transducer data) and potentiometric surfaces
- Regional Modeling Results (Northeast IL, Middle IL, Kankakee Region)
